


## Collaboration & Contributions in a Team Dynamic

<p>Fails to listen to, share with, and support the efforts of team members making accomplishing a task more difficult for the team.</p> <p>Frequently inattentive or distracting when team members talk. Requires frequent redirection by team members and/or teacher.</p> <p>Body language does not reflect engagement in the process. Focus on leaning in, asking questions, actively listening (e.g. make eye contact).</p> <p>Rarely offers feedback. Frequently becomes impatient, frustrated, and/or disrespectful.</p> <p>Limited attempts to move between roles.</p> <p>Does not use resources to support the team's work.</p>	<p>Attempts to listen to, share with, and support the efforts of team members are limited or inconsistent.</p> <p>Does not always listen when team members talk and requires redirection by team members and/or teacher.</p> <p>Body language does not reflect engagement in the process. Focus on leaning in, asking questions, actively listening (e.g. make eye contact).</p> <p>Occasionally offers feedback. At times, becomes impatient or frustrated with the process making teamwork more challenging.</p> <p>Limited attempts to move between roles.</p> <p>Does not consistently use resources to support the team's work.</p>	<p>Listens to, shares with, and supports the efforts of team members.</p> <p>Listens when team members talk.</p> <p>Attempts to engage in group tasks; however, body language does not consistently communicate interest or attention. Body language reflects engagement in the process, but there is room for improvement.</p> <p>Offers feedback and treats team members with respect. At times, becomes impatient or frustrated with the process making teamwork more challenging.</p> <p>Attempts to be flexible and move between roles; at times dominates a particular role. This is an area of potential growth.</p> <p>Uses resources to support the team's work.</p>	<p>Consistently listens to, shares with, and supports the efforts of team members.</p> <p>Leans in and actively listens when team members talk.</p> <p>Body language communicates interest in team tasks and engagement in the process.</p> <p>Offers constructive feedback, treats team members with respect, and is patient with the process.</p> <p>Creates balance on the team moving between responsibilities without dominating any one role.</p> <p>Uses resources effectively to support the team's work.</p>
